3. Feedback from recent funding	<p>Project Funding and Reporting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">AJ reported that nearly all the allocated project funding has now been spent.It was noted that Caergeiliog Council has not yet submitted their end-of-project report, and this remains outstanding. <p>Bro Llynnoedd Website</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">The Bro Llynnoedd website is progressing well.Its aim is to promote the alliance and its work and will include the ward as a whole.NT asked members to send it information they want to include on the websiteIt is scheduled to go live on 08/12/25. <p>Bodedern Village Hall</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">JA provided an update on Bodedern Village Hall:<ul style="list-style-type: none">Grant funding has been used to make the hall flooring secure again.Due to the severity of damp problems, it has been necessary to re-plaster the internal walls.These works have significantly improved the condition and safety of the building. <p>Sut Mae Dad' Project</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">The 'Sut Mae Dad' project has held sessions in both Valley and Bodedern.The project has successfully attracted participants and helped to raise awareness of men's mental health and the support available. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Caergeiliog Hall MM funding Officer awaiting confirmation that the work will be completed by the end of December, enabling us to release the funds. <p>Alliance Membership and Collaboration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MH suggested that all organisations and groups who applied for funding be invited to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Become members of the alliance; and ○ Contribute to its ongoing work. • This was seen to strengthen collaboration and ensure that funded projects remain connected to the wider strategic aims of the alliance. 	Alliance to explore this further and maybe place it in the T&C of applications.

Future Project and Funding opportunities	<p>Funding Update</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • AJ explained that there is currently no funding available, and that the service has experienced budget cuts this year. • As a result, Medrwn Môn cannot offer any financial support for projects at present. • AJ noted that the situation may become clearer in the next financial year, at which point she will be in a better position to confirm whether any funding can be made available. <p>Potential Travel and Disability Funding</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It was noted that there may be potential to explore support through Travel and Disability funding for Alliances. • This option will be investigated further to determine eligibility, criteria, and how such funding could be accessed and used to support ongoing and future activities.

Questions asked if the account was still needed. <p>Caffi Trwshio</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Concerns were raised regarding insurance for the Caffi Trwshio and where liability would lie.
